- 1. You must be 55 or older to submit. You may enter two (2) pieces
- 2. Professional/Experienced or Non-Professional
- 3. Must be ready to hang and for sale. The gallery <u>retains 25% of the sale</u>.
- 4. You must complete the label (BELOW) with your email submission
- **5.** Entry forms must be received by Friday, April 28, 2023 via email/mail. You **do not** have to send photos of your submissions.
- **6.** Artists who participate in the show will have their pieces placed in the ICA's Art of Aging Gallery inside Traditions Unlimited at 1608 West 8th Street, Erie, PA. Your work will be for sale in the gallery during the summer season May August 1, 2023. Any work not picked up by the "pick up by date" (AUGUST 1, 2023) or 30 days after (August 1, 2023) will become property of the ICA and the gallery to be raffled off or sold. Moneys received go to further shows and art projects.
- 7. Pieces will be delivered to the gallery May 2, 2023 to May 4, 2023. <u>During normal business</u> <u>hours: Monday-Friday 11:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.</u> When you deliver your work, it must be signed off by a member of the committee or employee of Traditions Unlimited. You will be asked to sign when work is delivered.
- **8. ALL WORK IS ACCEPTED:** Accepted: Water colors, oils, acrylic, photography (judged separately), ink, pencil, graphic media, mixed are accepted. Sorry no crafts of jewelry. If you have a piece in question call Ray at 814-881-3621. If you have apiece that requires "special care" please contact Ray prior to drop off.
- **9.** All art work must be picked up by August 1, 2023. If you work sells, you will receive a check at the end of the month in which it sold.

- **11.** Entries will be on display at the gallery from May 8- August 1, 2023, you may replace a piece of the same size if your work sells or you wish to exchange it.
- **12.** The Council reserves the right to reject any artwork due to content. Ownership of the artwork remains with the artist. The council reserves the right to photograph the artwork for promotional activities with credit to the artist if printed.
- **13.** The Independent Council on Aging and Traditions Unlimited will assume no liability for entries damaged or lost while in transit or on exhibited.
- **14.** Although the ICA/Traditions Unlimited and their volunteers take great care, they are not responsible for any damaged entries.
- 15. If your entry does not have an appropriate hanging on the back (wire) or approved by Ray Maholtz, and Craig Heuser Co-Chairs for event, it will not be accepted or judged in the show.

- 16. By signing and returning the entry form, artists agree to all terms and conditions of the exhibit.
- **17.** No laser prints, prints of any kind, facsimile or mechanical reproductions will be accepted. Only original artwork is to be submitted.
- **18.** Awards (1st, 2nd, 3rd) will be given in all categories: Photography, Professional, Non-Professional. Special Awards given for Best in Show, Erie Times-News, President's Choice, and Honorable Mentions. All winners will receive a ribbon and their names will be listed inside the Tri-State Senior News, as well as on the wall of the ICA Art of Aging Gallery, inside Traditions Unlimited gallery.
- **19.** There will be an artist reception for awards. The reception will be on Monday, May 15, 2023 from 2:30 4:00 p.m.
- 20. Any artist willing to donate a piece of art to our raffle will receive a mention in the program as "donated by". Money received from the raffle will benefit the ICA art show and senior artists.
- **21.** At the artists reception is when all ribbons and awards will be given.
