SPEAKER: Sara Benczkowski PT, DPT

- AHN: Vestibular Rehab in OP Center
- Mix of ortho, neuro, dizziness
- Dizziness: Feels like moving or room is moving
- 35% of adults 40 and older have experienced some sort of vestibular dysfunction
- 4% have chronic balance issues
- 1.1% report chronic dizziness problem
- Vertigo: illusion of movement even when at rest, is treatable
- 80% of adults over 65 have experienced some sort of dizziness
- 50% of these cases are caused by vertigo benign paroxysmal or Positional vertigo
- Signs and Symptoms: True room spinning, dizziness with specific movements, fatigue, nausea/vomiting, headache, blurred/double vision, ringing in ears
- Referral sources can be PCP, Neurologist, ENT, PT
- Vestibular Rehab: uses head and body movements to strengthen the connection between eyes, vesticular system, brain, and body
- Reposition the crystals in your ears to abolish dizziness
- Most common: Epley maneuver
- Other causes: Medication, hypotension, infectious diseases, Endocrine Diseases, Hematologic Disorder, panic attack/hyperventilation, and dehydration
- What to do? Check medication regularly, go to annual wellness check, and have vision/hearing tested
- Exercise ideas for Seniors: Look as far up and as far down x 10 times, look as far left and as far right x 10 times; without using your hands, stand up from chair x 10 times
